Girl Scouts of Southwest Texas has a state flag for each of our 50 states and 144 International flags representing each member of the World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts (WAGGGS). Flag check-out procedures are:

- ▶ Members may check-out up to 15 state and/or international flags.
- ▶ The flags measure 3'x5' and are mounted on 7', ONE PIECE POLES. The poles **DO NOT** break down into 2 pieces.
- ▶ The flags must be completely enclosed in the transporting vehicle. Pole(s) **CANNOT** stick out of windows or doors during transport so **plan accordingly**.
- ▶ The flags must be rolled and covered during transportation. Persons requesting use of international flags and equipment are responsible for rolling and covering, loading and unloading the requested equipment.
- ▶ Multi-flag stands are available for check-out, however, they weigh 35 - 40 pounds each and must be moved with care.

Flags should be scheduled for pick-up no more than **TWO DAYS PRIOR** to date of use and returned within **TWO DAYS AFTER** date of use. All equipment borrowed from the Resource Center **MUST BE RETURNED ON TIME!** **Equipment returned late will be charged \$2.00 per day. A cleaning fee of \$5.00 will be charged for any item being returned in need of cleaning. You will be charged for lost or damaged items. Fees incurred will be deducted from the deposit. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
