

2024 H-E-B Booth Agreement

Girl Scouts of Southwest Texas depends on the generosity of businesses to provide locations for cookie booth opportunities and depends on adult volunteers and girls to abide by the guidelines set by these businesses.

By signing this form, you agree that your troop will be in full compliance with the specific H-E-B requests and Girl Scouts of Southwest Texas' requirements. Troops found to be non-compliant will not be allowed at any future council-sponsored sites.

3 requirements are mandatory for all girls/troops who participate at an H-E-B Cookie booth site:

- 1. Complete the GSSWT H-E-B Healthy Living Patch Program on or before Monday, March 4, 2024.
 - o Troop agrees to display the H-E-B/GSSWT partnership table display at all H-E-B booths.
- 2. The Troop Cookie Manager must utilize the <u>Booth Sale Recorder</u> (in eBudde *or* on the eBudde app) to allocate cookies to girls who participated in the H-E-B booth(s). Council **must** track all sales at H-E-B locations to let them know the significance of our partnership. Complete your troop's Booth Sale Recorder entry as soon as possible after the booth (but NO LATER THAN Monday, March 4, 2024).
- 3. Sign and return this agreement to the Product Program department *no later than the troops first scheduled H-E-B booth date*. Please email picture or scan to <u>customercare@girlscouts-swtx.org</u>.

This form MUST be signed by BOTH the Troop Leader AND Troop Cookie Manager.

	All adults helping at an H-E-B booth location must review booth procedures and guidelines, and complete a Booth Etiquette Agreement o See the Booth Do's and Don'ts under the Booths section on the Cookie Webpage
	Absolutely no more than 2 adults and 4 girls are allowed at the booth sites. Tag-a-longs (siblings and/or friends) are not permitted. No adult-only booths.
	Troops will only use <u>H-E-B</u> plastic bags or generic (non-branded) bags—bags are not provided.
	Troops are required to record ALL H-E-B booth sales in the booth recorder in eBudde website or App.
	If you are unable to make it to your scheduled H-E-B booth site, you MUST "release" it on eBudde at least <u>2 dayselease</u> before the date to ensure that another troop has an opportunity to fill the slot.
	Begin packing up your booth 5 minutes before end of scheduled 2-hour shift. All customers at the end of your shift belong to the next troop. Smooth and considerate transfer of troops at sites is imperative. • If the next troop does NOT show up, the troop at the site may stay until they do show up but MUST be prepared to pack up quickly and leave if/when the troop shows up.
	Troop must have a copy of this H-E-B Booth agreement at each site.
	The special H-E-B/GSSWT partnership table display (last page in this packet) must be visibly displayed at your booth table during your time slot(s). If needed, you can obtain color copies from the SCGSLC Resource Center.
	 If a situation occurs while at the booth and you ask store security, staff or management for assistance, you must report it on the day of the occurrence by calling 210-349-2404/1-800-580-7247. If during GSSWT business hours, ask for the Product Program department. You must ALSO contact Whitney White, H-E-B Public Affairs on weekdays at 309-230-8223. If during the weekend, call the number and press 1; the automated phone system will forward the call directly to the council's ICE (In Case of Emergency) cell phone. You must ALSO contact Whitney White on weekends at white.whitney@heb.com.
