



Camp Metro Covid-19 Protocol 2022

1. Girl Scouts of Southwest Texas follows the recommended guidelines set by San Antonio Metro Health, the Texas Department of State Health Services and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).
2. All staff and campers are required to wear a face mask, receive temperature check and answer health screening questions when arriving each day and when entering the building.
3. Classrooms will have limited number of girls from 6-8 girls with 2 to 3 counselors.
4. Social distancing will be implemented for group activities and during lunch.
5. Campers who ride the bus from the Sally Cheever Girl Scout Leadership Center will have designated seats with alternating empty rows/seats to comply with social distancing. Face masks are required for campers, staff and bus driver while riding the bus. Buses will be sanitized before and after each route.
6. Hand sanitizer stations will be placed in the hallway and classrooms. Hand washing is implemented after every activity, before lunch, restroom breaks, and other times when needed.
7. Classrooms and equipment are sanitized throughout the day and end of each day.
8. Only campers, camp staff and camp support personnel will be allowed in the building to prevent and reduce the spread of COVID-19.
9. Drop off and pick up will be curbside service only. Parents/family members will remain in the car.
 - a. When dropping off your camper, the camp nurse will conduct daily checks (temperature, screening questions). The camper will exit the car with mask on and be escorted inside the building.
 - b. When picking up your camper, camp staff will come to your car and ask for your camper's name. Staff will call for your camper and they will be brought to the car.
