Important Parent Reminders for Digital Cookie®

1. Register for Digital Cookie



Look for a Digital Cookie registration email in your inbox to register! If you didn't receive one let us know at customer-care@girlscouts-swtx.org.

2. Set Up Your Site



Set your sales goal, share your cookie store and, upload a fun picture or video. Then publish & go!

3. Invite Customers



Use the email in Digital Cookie to reach out to customers. Ask them to visit your cookie site, purchase and share!

4. Track Your Progress



Use your Digital Cookie to track your online sales and keep up with your goals!

Customers have the option to place orders for:

- **Girl-delivered**—Girls will request cookies and deliver directly to these customers
- **Shipped**—Cookies are shipped directly to the customer as the orders are received
- **Donated**—All donated cookies orders online will be given to the USO

What to do for girl-delivered orders?

1. Review the Order

Are these customers you or your Girl Scout know? And are you willing to deliver to this customers location?

Always review orders before approving!



2. Approve or Deny—5 Days

Approve if you know the customer and are willing to deliver to them; Deny if you don't know the customer or they are too far!

All orders must be approved/denied within five days!

3. Request Cookies

If the order is approved before initial order due date, cookies will be received with your initial order and you don't need to request them.

After initial order is submitted, you must ask your Troop Cookie Manager for cookies to fill these orders.

4. Deliver to Customers

Your Girl Scout with an adult should deliver cookies to customers within two week of receiving the order.

Girls can include a thank you note and even a QR code to their online site for reordering!
