
Cookie Program Info for Parents

- Wed., Mar. 5—Digital Cookie closes for the season—ALL girl-delivered orders should be delivered by this date





Initial Order

Who: All girls with a permission slip can participate in booths & more


How: As cookies are needed—talk to your TCM and provide them a complete list of what is needed. Your TCM can also sign your troop up for booths.


NOTE: You should only ever have an **unpaid balance of \$500 per girl (i.e. 100 unsold packages) at any time**—your TCM may request a deposit as needed














Program Money

- Paper order cards—Customer pays cash or credit/debit card via Digital Cookie at the time of delivery
- Online orders—Customers pay with a credit card for online orders in Digital Cookie
- 100% of money is due to troop account BY Fri., Mar. 7—parents should make final deposits on:
- Money can be given to the TCM, Co-Leaders, or Money Managers and a receipt must be completed
- All parents will have an amount due in cash to the troop—unless all orders were placed on Digital Cookie
- Cookie money should **NEVER** be put into your personal account
